#### PRAYER FOR READING HOLY SCRIPTURES

"Shine within our hearts, loving Master, the pure light of Your divine knowledge and open the eyes of our minds that we may comprehend the message of Your Gospel. EPISTLE -Ephesians 5:8-19

Brethren, walk as children of light (for the fruit At that time, as Jesus drew near to Jericho, a true), and try to learn what is pleasing to the Lord. Take no part in the unfruitful works of darkness, but instead expose them. For it is a shame even to speak of the things that they do of David, have mercy on me!" #### **FREE WILL**

As news about the arrival of robots into our world is reported, a new heresy of our time has arisen. Wiring and circuitry in robots is often compared to organs and neurons in the body. If robots can be programmed to act like humans without having human free will, then the question is posed as to whether human free will even exists? Our Saints, however, have demonstrated that humans do have free will; for, the exercise of their free will indicates that, indeed, the soul can be the ruler of the body. The voluntary will to fast; to pray; to give of one's self out of care for others (sacrificial love) is all proof that we are created with free will, which is a beautiful quality of the soul.

Today's Epistle and Gospel passages illustrate the power of our human free will. In his Epistle to the Ephesians, St. Paul implies that it is in the power of our free will to *open our eyes* and come out of the darkness and to *choose* whether to be drunk with wine, or to take into ourselves the Holy Spirit. In the Gospel today, we find a man who willingly prayed to Christ our God for mercy. Biology does not have an easy answer for the fact that, when told to "be quiet" by others, the blind man *willingly* all the more shouted, "Have mercy on me, O Son of David." On the basis of his faith, he willingly prayed for healing and our Savior responded, "Your faith has made you well."

Any idea that humans do not have a free will is a deception from the devil so that we fall into the error of believing that we are not responsible for how we think and what we do. Accordingly, evil is the fault of something or someone else, and therefore it is a mistake to believe in such things as *sin* or *virtue*. Let us not be duped into believing that we are just "god-like" machines in the flesh. Such a notion is of the anti-Christ...the very corruption of the reality of God in the flesh, Who is Christ. To say that we have no free will is to ignore the fact that human willpower, coupled with God's grace, is what lies behind miracles. By all means, let us welcome Christ our God into our lives starting from now! +FR. THEODORE

Καθώς μεταδίδονται νέα για την δημιουργία των ρομπότ στον κόσμο μας, μια νέα αίρεση της εποχής μας έχει εμφανισθεί μπροστά μας. Τα καλώδια και τα συστήματα στα ρομπότ συχνά συγκρίνονται με όργανα και νευρώνες του σώματός μας. Εάν τα ρομπότ μπορούν να προγραμματισθούν να ενεργούν σαν άνθρωποι χωρίς να έχουν το αυτεξούσιον (δηλ. την ανθρώπινη ελεύθερη βούληση), τότε τίθεται το ερώτημα εάν ακόμη υπάρχει το αυτεξούσιον του ανθρώπου (δηλ. την ανθρώπινη ελεύθερη βούληση)! Οι Άγιοί μας, ωστόσο, έχουν αποδείξει ότι οι άνθρωποι έχουν ελεύθερη βούληση, γιατί η άσκηση της ελεύθερης βουλήσεώς των μας δείχνει ότι, πράγματι, η ψυχή μπορεί να κυβερνήσει το σώμα. Η εθελοντική θέληση για να νηστεύσουμε, για να προσευχηθούμε; για να προσφέρουμε κάτι από τον εαυτό μας από φροντίδα για άλλους (η θυσιαστική αγάπη) — είναι όλα αποδείξεις ότι έχουμε δημιουργηθεί με ελεύθερη βούληση, που είναι η ιδιότητα της ψυχής.

Οι σημερινές περικοπές της Επιστολής και του Ευαγγελίου δείχνουν τη δύναμη της ανθρώπινης ελεύθερης βουλήσεώς μας. Στην προς Εφεσίους Επιστολή του, ο Άγιος Παύλος υπονοεί ότι είναι στη δύναμη της ελεύθερης βουλήσεώς μας να ανοίξουμε τα μάτια μας και να βγούμε από το σκοτάδι και να επιλέξουμε αν θα μεθύσουμε με κρασί ή εάν θα πάρουμε μέσα μας το Άγιο Πνεύμα. Στο Ευαγγέλιο σήμερα, ευρίσκουμε έναν άνθρωπο που προσευχήθηκε πρόθυμα στον Χριστό για το Θείο έλεος. Η βιολογία δεν έχει μια εύκολη απάντηση για το γεγονός ότι, όταν του είπαν οι άλλοι να «σιωπήσει,» ο τυφλός πρόθυμα εφώναξε όλο και περισσότερο «Ελέησόν με, Υιέ του Δαβίδ». Με βάση της πίστεώς του, επροσευχήθηκε πρόθυμα να θεραπευθεί και ο Χριστός του είπε: «Η πίστις σου σε έκανε καλά».

Η ιδέα ότι οι άνθρωποι δεν έχουν ελεύθερη βούληση (το αυτεξούσιον) είναι μια εξαπάτηση από τον διάβολο, ώστε να πέσουμε στο λάθος να πιστέψουμε ότι δεν είμεθα υπεύθυνοι για το πώς σκεφτόμεθα και για το τι κάνουμε. Σύμφωνα με μια τέτοια αίρεση, το κακό δεν γίνεται από εμάς, αλλά συμβαίνει από κάτι άλλο ή από κάπιον άλλον, και επομένως είναι λάθος να πιστεύουμε σε κάτι πράγματα όπως η αμαρτία ή η αρετή. Οι δαίμονες θέλουν να μας εξαπατήσουν ώστε να πιστεύουμε ότι είμεθα απλώς «θεόμορφες» μηχανές στην σάρκα. Μια τέτοια αντίληψη είναι για τον αντί-Χριστό...ακριβώς μιά μεγάλη διαφθορά από την πραγματικότητα του εν σαρκί Θεού, ο Οποίος είναι ο Χριστός. Το να πούμε ότι δεν έχουμε ελεύθερη βούληση σημαίνει ότι αγνοούμε το γεγονός ότι η ανθρώπινη θέληση, σε συνδυασμό με τη χάρη του Θεού, δημιουργεί θαύματα. Ας μην ξεγελιόμεθα! Με κάθε τρόπο, ας φέρουμε τον Χριστό στη ζωή μας από τώρα! +Ο ΠΑΤΗΡ ΘΕΟΔΩΡΟΣ

Thy Nativity, O Christ our God,


Has shine the light of knowledge upon the world,
